

Route to Qualification

NORTH LONDON  SKYDIVING



Standard Tandem Skydive
(which you may have just completed)



Second Tandem Skydive for conversion to Level 2 of the Accelerated Free Fall Course **COST - £200**

A more personal service which includes one hour ground school. Must occur within six months of Standard Tandem Skydive. Jumps and training take place mid-week.



Accelerated Free Fall (AFF) Ground School **COST - £120**

Allow one full day (mid-week).



AFF LEVEL 2 JUMP COST - £215
AIMS: Stability. Altitude awareness. Able to deploy own parachute.

Must be completed within 3 months of conversion Tandem Skydive. **Full British Parachute Association (BPA) Membership also required COST £93.94** - at time of printing.



AFF LEVEL 3 JUMP COST - £215
AIMS: Able to maintain a freefall heading without instructor assistance.



AFF LEVEL 4 JUMP COST - £135
AIMS: Start and stop turns.



AFF LEVEL 5 JUMP COST - £135
AIMS: 360 degree turns in either direction.



AFF LEVEL 6 JUMP COST - £135
AIMS: Back loops and Horizontal movement across the sky known as "Tracking".



AFF LEVEL 7 JUMP COST - £135
AIMS: Dive exit. 360 degree turns. Back loop. Tracking and Track turns.



AFF LEVEL 8 JUMP COST - £40
AIMS: Solo exit and deploy within 10 secs.



10 x CONSOLIDATION JUMPS **COST - £35 EACH**
AIMS: Practice jumps on your own. Can be started after AFF level 7.



British Parachute Association "A" Licence Awarded

Congratulations you are now a fully qualified skydiver with a licence that is recognised throughout the world.

You can continue jumping with us on a regular basis (without the need to book) for just **£18 per jump** – excluding equipment hire (which is available for **£12 per jump** as long as you need it).

Your next goal is to obtain your B, C and D Licences.

This involves moving onto more advanced disciplines, jumping with others, learning how to pack parachutes and perhaps even looking at purchasing your own equipment – which we can advise you on as and when the time comes. A new "Rig" for example costs around £5000. A good second hand Rig around £3500.



BPA "B" Licence
50 jumps + Canopy Handling (CH) Grade 2 & Jump Master (JM) Grade 1

This licence allows you to:-

- Jump with camera equipment
- Qualify as a coach
- Take part in parachute displays and lots more...



BPA "C" Licence
200 jumps + Grade 1 in Formation Skydiving (FS), or Free Flying (FF), or Canopy Formations (CH), or Individual Style (IS).



BPA "D" Licence 1000 jumps

This Licence allows you to become a:-

- Tandem Instructor
- AFF Instructor
- Advanced Instructor
- Club Chief Instructor (CCI)
- Examiner
